The fourth annual Grail conference will take place in southern Germany, exploring the Grail connections there. Central to this exploration is Rudolf Steiner's indication quoted above.

As Kaspar Hauser in a spiritual communication to Estelle Isaacson on July 2, 2009, indicated: *"You have great spiritual protection because of the childlike forces, which are streaming into you. Spiritually, children have an added measure of spiritual protection. When people are baptized in a proper way they are given extra spiritual protection because a part of them is truly being made new; they have the opportunity to connect to their childlike forces and become as a little child who deserves the kingdom of God. And I, the being who was Kasper Hauser, am an inspiration for the sacrament of baptism. I am the one who escorts the childlike forces—forces which belong to each soul who receives true baptism. This is my work, for my heart is with the being of each soul who has not fallen, and I care for this aspect of the soul. I work to maintain the purity and innocence of those forces when they are called up to enter into the soul of any human being, such as you have experienced. And so I assist you in keeping this childlike part of you innocent and pure and safe and protected."* This indication can be seen in relation to Rudolf Steiner's statement about Parsifal, the Grail king, representing the pure "I".

As well as entering into the deep and profound Grail mysteries connected with Kaspar Hauser, we shall also make excursions to Grail sites located in this area. The focus in cosmic dance will be on the ascent through the planetary spheres after death, the encounter with Christ, the lord of karma,

and the journey of the soul into incarnation—with musical accompaniment by Italian pianist Fabio Berellini.

“Between death and rebirth our perfections and imperfections are faithfully recorded in the Akasha Chronicle. Certain attributes are inscribed in the Moon sphere, others in the Venus sphere, others in the Mars sphere, others in the Mercury sphere, others in the Jupiter sphere, and so on. When we are returning to an incarnation in a physical body and our being is slowly contracting, we encounter everything that was inscribed on the outward journey. In this way our karma is prepared.”(R. Steiner, *Life Between Death and Rebirth*, GA 140).

Rudolf Steiner indicated in his last lecture how we are living in a world crisis. As we have seen in the current events, humanity is increasingly confronted with a multitude of questions in moral terms - for example, in relation to our health and our freedom, as well as to the well-being of Mother Earth. As the tensions seem to be widening at the moment, it becomes all the more important that we learn to understand the spiritual realities behind this event - and equip ourselves with the awakening to be guided through it. This world crisis is such that humanity cannot handle it on its own. We need the help of the spiritual world. The process of getting to know the leading spiritual beings who work into world development is complex and profound. In this seminar, we will have the opportunity to enter into resonance with them as we dance cosmic dances to form an etheric temple here on earth, into which they can work.

The week of this fourth Grail seminar with Estelle Isaacson and Robert Powell will begin with the opening concert on Sunday, August 5, 2018 at 8:00 pm (22:00). The seminar will end with departure after breakfast on Saturday, August 11, 2018.

Ettal Abbey to Linderhof Castle, both in Ettal—approx. 15 minutes drive

Linderhof Castle to the guesthouse in Peiting 43 km (27 miles)—driving time about 45 minutes
