Here with some practical information concerning the Mont Sainte-Odile (Odilienberg) seminar/conference in the Alsace/France region from **31. Juli—6. August 2017.**

For this seminar/conference I have reserved accommodation and meals (organic and vegetarian)—and also a room for choreocosmos (sacred dance)—in L’Ermitage <http://www.ermitage-alsace.com/>, which is a 20-minute drive south-west of Mont Sainte-Odile.

Two others seminars will be taking place at Clos-Ermitage at the same time as ours.

Why are we not having our seminar/conference at the *Hostellerie* at Mont Sainte-Odile?

It is because the cost of staying there is so high that it would have been impossible, being so expensive, for many people to attend the seminar/conference.

We are happy, therefore, to have found L’Ermitage, even though the cost of our seminar/conference there will be higher than the price of the September 2016 seminar in Saint-Guilhem. The following price indications for L’Ermitage are for full pension (all meals at L’Ermitage):

- 1 (single) bedroom at a hotel, 10 minutes walk from L’Ermitage = 491,70€
- 2 beds room at L’Ermitage = 425,70€ per person
- 3 or 4 beds room at L’Ermitage = 350,70€ per person

And the fee for attending the seminar/conference will be 450€ per person.

Prior to departure, the participants staying at L’Ermitage are requested to clean their room and make the bed—ready for the next visitors. ALTERNATIVELY: If you do not want to do the cleaning—or if you have to leave the hotel early—you can pay 18€ for the cleaning of a 2 beds room or 27€ for a 3 or 4 beds rooms (to be shared among those staying in the bedroom).

This year it is necessary to request a deposit of 100€ from everyone for registration for the seminar/conference. This is because I am paying out of my own financial resources for the advance rental of L’Ermitage and also for the reservation of a bus/coach for the two excursions planned—see above announcement. Because of widespread interest already being shown in this seminar/conference, early registration is advisable.

If you register, paying the 100€ deposit, and subsequently discover that you are unable to attend, then provided you communicate this to me *before the middle of June 2017*, the 100€ deposit will be refunded. After mid-June, however, deposits will not be refunded but will go toward helping to cover various expenses incurred in organizing the seminar/conference.

Regarding the 100€ deposit: I will send my bank account information for the deposit of this amount to all who definitely wish to register for this seminar/conference. After reading this information, if you decide you would like to attend, please let me know as soon as possible.
