This weekend we will be exploring Christ's seven last words from the cross, and the redemption of the interior of the Earth in relation to the Lazarus-John and the Elijah-John individualities. On Holy Saturday Christ descended into the depths of the Earth in order to redeem the interior of the Earth. His descent penetrated the Cain region near the center of the Earth. Rudolf Steiner indicated that Lazarus-John, the disciple whom Christ loved, was the reincarnated Cain, who has his dominion in the interior of the Earth.

Following Rudolf Steiner's last lecture, given on September 28, 1924, Johanna von Keyserlingk indicated that "the spiritual paths of Lazarus-John lead to the. . . mysteries of the Earth's depths, and the spiritual paths of Elijah-John the Baptist lead into the Light regions of the Buddha-sphere." And it is the Elijah-John individuality who is to be the bearer of strength in the next step toward spiritual evolution.

The Holy Saturday Mysteries still hidden in the Earth are the Saturn mysteries of Lazarus-Cain, which we will consider in light of the Buddha Mysteries of Elijah-John.

Choreocosmos returns movement to the realm of the sacred, as a path toward furthering the development of the human being. Through Cosmic and Sacred Dance one creates sacred space within the self, within the community and with the cosmos and beings of nature. It is a healing force and source of joy.

CHOREOCOSMOS, the school of Cosmic and Sacred Dance, was founded by Robert Powell, PhD, with the intention of aligning one's self harmoniously with the spiritual-cosmic world and to celebrate the relationship of the human being with the cosmos and the earth.
