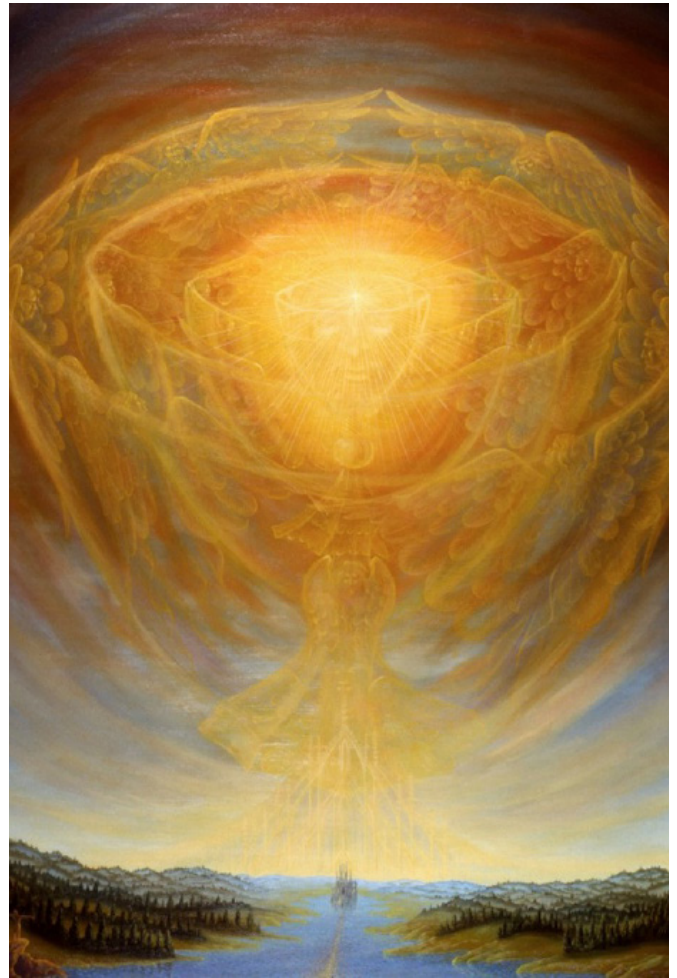

SOCIAL AND ECCLESIASTIC SACRAMENTALISM

This year the three primary themes upon which we will be focusing are:

- a deepening exploration of the Mystery of Golgotha,
- the Sacrament of Communion in relation to social and ecclesiastic sacramentalism,
- and *Meditations on the Old Testament* by Valentin Tomberg, as the background leading to the Christ event on Golgotha.

Rudolf Steiner once declared that the greatest of “mysteries” in the story of humanity is “the appearance of God on Earth among humans, as Christ in Jesus, and what His crucifixion on Golgotha accomplished.”

The gathering will begin with dinner at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday evening, July 2, followed by the Beatitudes Grail Circle. The program will end on Monday morning, July 6, with breakfast, after the Mass of the Lamb and His Bride and the sacrament of Alchemical Baptism on Sunday evening.
