

GREAT CONJUNCTION 2020-12-21: A CALL TO HUMAN BEINGS TO OPEN THEIR HEARTS

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According to the wisdom of Australian Aboriginal Elders, the most important cosmic event ever prophesied is coming up on Monday, December 21, 2020, which is the day of the winter solstice in the northern hemisphere. For the Aborigines this is the time of the summer solstice, since Uluru, in the middle of Australia, is in the southern hemisphere.

On this date there will be a special astronomical event: one of the closest conjunctions of Jupiter and Saturn in 397 years visible to the naked eye, since the conjunction of these two planets on July 16 in 1623. On December 21, the day of the conjunction, Jupiter and Saturn will be separated by only 10 minutes of arc, and may appear to the naked eye as a single bright object in the heavens. For many, the two planets will seem to be completely merged together, although careful observation should be able to distinguish between them in the night sky.

See below an artist's conception of Jupiter and Saturn in December 2020, noting that on December 16, 2020, the new waxing crescent of the Moon is also part of the view at the tail end of Sagittarius. (Chart via Jay Ryan¹).

Two days before, on December 14, there is a total eclipse of the Sun, with the Sun and Moon in conjunction at 28° Scorpio ("tail of the Scorpion") and 2 days 3 hours later after the total solar eclipse, the Moon and Pluto are in conjunction at 28½° Sagittarius, at which time the Sun will have entered Sagittarius—see image.

On December 21 Jupiter and Saturn will first become visible during twilight, close to the western horizon in the southern hemisphere, or the southwestern horizon in the northern hemisphere. After first sighting, they will set within approximately two hours—varying somewhat according to location—so it is important to have a clear view toward the western or southwestern horizon shortly after sunset.

For all who are in the time zone Eastern Standard Time, the great conjunction will be at exactly 1:20pm EST—corresponding to 3:50am on December 22 in Uluru—noting that the solstice will already have taken place 8h 18m earlier on December 21 at 5:02am EST, corresponding to 7:32pm on December 21 at Uluru—this being the exact time of the summer solstice there. It will be at that time of the summer solstice, during the hours around or immediately following the solstice, that the Aborigines will be celebrating the event at Uluru.

As a result of the lengthy periods of their planetary orbits of the zodiac, Jupiter and Saturn meet in the heavens only once every 20 years. In this period of time, Saturn completes two-thirds of its 30-year orbit (since 20 is two-thirds of 30). In the same period, Jupiter completes one 12-year orbit, plus, in the remaining 8 years, two-thirds of its next orbit (since 8 is two-thirds of 12). In other words, 20 years is the time it takes Jupiter to catch up and pass Saturn

again as they circle around the zodiac. The above figures are round numbers. More precise figures are 11.86 years for Jupiter's orbital period, 29.46 years for Saturn's orbital period, and 19.86 years for the average time period of a conjunction between the two planets. As can be seen from the above image, the conjunction of Jupiter and Saturn on December 21, 2020, takes place in the constellation/sidereal sign of Capricorn, the Goat, at $5\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ Capricorn.²

Twenty years earlier the previous great conjunction of Jupiter and Saturn was on May 28, 2000, in the constellation/sidereal sign of Aries. At that time, Jupiter and Saturn were in exact conjunction, but were too close to the Sun for this exact conjunction to be seen by the naked eye. And the next great conjunction will be on November 5, 2040, in the constellation/sidereal sign of Virgo, connecting onto the rare threefold great conjunction of Jupiter and Saturn in Virgo on December 31, 1980, March 4, 1981, and July 24, 1981, signifying an influx of the impulse of Divine Sophia, with whom the Virgin Mary is connected, bearing in mind that at her birth the Sun was in the middle of the constellation/sidereal sign of Virgo, at 16° Virgo.³ What do the great conjunctions signify?

In the new star wisdom of astrosophy it is a matter of understanding the spiritual influences connected with each of the

planets: in this case Saturn and Jupiter. Saturn is the planet of cosmic memory, remembering everything that took place in the past, and thus having an overview of every human being's destiny (karma) accumulated through all incarnations going back to the very first incarnation after the Fall. Jupiter, on the other hand, is the planet of cosmic thought, the great thinker of the cosmos. The coming together (conjunction) of these two planets activates, on the basis of the past, the underlying cosmic thoughts planning the new 20-year Jupiter-Saturn cycle just beginning, by way of planning ahead what should take place culturally for humanity and the Earth during the new 20-year cycle now commencing. And the zodiacal sign where the conjunction occurs in the zodiac also plays into the seed impulse sown for the next cultural cycle of twenty years. The zodiacal background to the conjunction colors the cultural impulse that is about to unfold.

For example, as mentioned already, the influence of Virgo played into the threefold conjunction of Jupiter and Saturn in 1981. This was the time of an opening up to the Divine Feminine, as evident from all the books on the theme of the Divine Feminine that began to be published at that time. Moreover, between the second and the third of the three Jupiter-Saturn conjunctions at that time, appearances of Mary began on St John's Day (June 24) in 1981 and continued on a daily basis.

Since 1981, in a small village in Bosnia-Herzegovina named Medjugorje, Mary has been appearing and giving messages to the world. She tells us that God has sent Her to our world, and these years She is spending with us are a time of Grace granted by God. In Her own words She tells us, *"I have come to tell the world that God exists. He is the fullness of life, and to enjoy this fullness and peace, you must return to God"*. Our Lady's mission is one of peace. She has come to earth to reeducate us and to help us convert and recenter our lives back to God. Our Lady's role has always been one of guiding people to Her Son, Jesus. What an amazing opportunity we have before us! Our Lady's call to conversion is urgent, and we should respond with all our hearts. Our Lady continues to give messages to six people from the village of Medjugorje: Ivan, Jakov, Marija, Mirjana, Vicka, and Ivanka. These six

people (referred to as “visionaries”) have received apparitions of Mary since June 24, 1981.

Since the apparitions began in 1981, approximately 40 million people of all faiths, from all over the world, have visited Medjugorje and have left spiritually strengthened and renewed. Many bring back stories of miracles in the form of healings (of mind, body and spirit), supernatural visual signs, and deep conversions back to God. You [are invited] to investigate with an open mind and heart the messages which are given to us by Our Lady of Medjugorje.⁴

Let us recall that from 1963 to 1992 Bosnia-Herzegovina was one of the six constituent federal states forming the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia. In other words, Bosnia-Herzegovina was communist. And it was during that time that the appearances of Mary in Medjugorje began.

The wave of peaceful revolutions that commenced on February 6, 1989, and continued until January 1, 1992, resulted in the end of communist rule in Central and Eastern Europe and beyond. In Yugoslavia, the Socialist Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina was dissolved in 1990, when it abandoned its socialist institutions and adopted liberal ones, becoming the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina, which then declared independence from Yugoslavia in 1992.

What is little known is the extraordinary impact of the collective spiritual impulse of the prayers for peace stemming from the devoted hearts and souls of the millions of pilgrims from around the world coming to Medjugorje, whereby this collective spiritual impulse influenced from “behind the scenes” the wave of peaceful revolutions throughout Russia and its satellite countries comprising the Soviet Union that led to the collapse of Soviet communism.⁵

There is much that could be told about the role of Our Lady of Medjugorje with regard to the peaceful revolutions that changed the face of Europe during the years 1989-1992. However, this would lead too far from our present theme.

From the example given here of the threefold conjunction of Jupiter and Saturn in Virgo in 1981, much can be learned about how heavenly influences work powerfully into the cultural history of humanity—in this case during the 20-year cycle between the great conjunctions of Jupiter and Saturn. Based on this understanding, what can we anticipate with regard to the upcoming great conjunction of Jupiter and Saturn in Capricorn on December 21?

As a starting point, let us return to consider the Aboriginal prophecy relating to the summer solstice at Uluru on December 21. Some Aboriginal Elders have let it be known that this prophecy is about the finding and opening of a *magic receptacle* in the shape of a rock said by them to have been left hidden at Uluru by cosmic beings from the Pleiades, known as the “Seven Sisters” in Greek mythology. It is prophesied that the receptacle/rock will be found on this important date of the summer solstice in the year 2020. According to the prophecy, within the rock a set of crystals will be found, having been left in this receptacle by the beings from the Pleiades. However, there is an element of uncertainty belonging to the prophecy, given that it depends upon the magic rock actually being found at Uluru on the day of the summer solstice 2020-12-21. According to the Aboriginal Elders, if the rock is found, the receptacle—or rather the set of crystals in it—could be activated, with profound consequences for humanity and the Earth.

The Aboriginal Elders say that the importance and significance of the Pleiadian Seven Sisters activation of these crystals at Uluru could give birth to a New Earth and the rising again of the lost continent of Lemuria, whence the Aborigines originally came, having left Lemuria prior to the submergence of that great continent that at one time long ago had been located in the region

of the Indian Ocean. It is evident that prior to the destruction of Lemuria there were two great exoduses from that continent, and that the ancestors of the present-day Australian Aborigines came from Lemuria to Australia with the exodus that went southeast.⁶

Also important in terms of our consideration of the prophecy of the Aboriginal Elders is that the great monolithic rock of Uluru marks the location of the root chakra of the Earth.

In the book *Astrogeographia* by David Bowden and myself, the question is considered whether there is a correspondence between the seven continents and the seven classical planets? The answer given in chapter 10 of the book is in the affirmative, if we follow the indications of Rudolf Steiner, as described below. As can be seen from a map, Australia is the largest land mass belonging to the continent of Oceania, that includes Australasia, Melanesia, Micronesia, and Polynesia.

It is not surprising, therefore, to find according to *Astrogeographia* that—on the continent of Oceania, a veritable “watery continent” spread out over the Pacific Ocean and beyond—the Earth’s root chakra is located there. The Aborigines refer to Uluru as the *center of the world*. Without having a different conception of the world, knowing only Australia, the impressive sacred site of Uluru, formerly known as Ayer’s Rock, being located centrally in Australia, appeared to them to be the center of the world.

Currently there are considered to be seven continents: North America, South America, Europe, Africa, Asia, Oceania (also known as Australasia), and Antarctica. In terms of these continents having human populations related to the seven classical planets (Saturn, Jupiter, Mars, Sun, Venus, Mercury, Moon), Antarctica (uninhabited) can be left out of consideration.

They are recognized as the first nations of Southern Africa, whose territories span Botswana, Namibia, Angola, Zambia, Zimbabwe, Lesotho, and South Africa.

However, if the largest continent, Asia, were to be divided into two on the basis of ethnic considerations, there would be seven continents with human populations. The basis for considering a division of Asia along these lines was originally put forward by a German scholar Johann Friedrich Blumenbach (1752-1840), who maintained that ethnically the natives of maritime Southeast Asia should be grouped into a single category: the Malays, a term that continued to be used in the late 19th and early 20th centuries, and is sometimes still employed today.

The region occupied by the Malays includes the Malayan Peninsula, Eastern Sumatra (of Indonesia), coastal Borneo, and Southern Thailand, as well as the smaller islands which lie between these locations—areas that are collectively known as the *Malay world*.

In our book *Astrogeographia*, this region is counted as a continent separate from Asia, on the basis of Rudolf Steiner's identification of the human population of this region, the Malays, as that of the "Venus people"—as opposed to the rest of Asia whom Steiner identified as the geographical region populated by the "Mars people."⁷

As referred to above, one of the seven continents is Oceania, often simply identified with Australia. According to Robert Coon, the Earth chakra on this continent is Uluru,⁸ formerly known to non-Aborigines as Ayers Rock, a large sandstone formation in the center of Australia, which is also a World Heritage site. It is the second largest monolith in the world (after Mount Augustus, also in Australia). Uluru is sacred to the Aborigines and is important in their creation mythology. Archeological research shows that the Uluru area has been inhabited by human beings for at least 10,000 years, and some sources maintain that the Aborigines have been there for at least 20,000 years. Uluru, with its distinctive color, glowing red at dawn and sunset, is one of Australia's most recognizable national landmarks.

Our research indicates that Uluru is indeed the location of the Earth's Moon chakra, lying on the great ley artery running through the Externsteine, Mount Kailash, Mount Agung, and Uluru—the chakras on the continents corresponding to Jupiter (Europe), Mars (Asia), Venus (Malaysia, not the country, but the region of the Malays), and the Moon (Australasia or Oceania). The other great ley artery runs through Lake Titicaca, Mount Shasta, and Mount Kailash—the chakras on the continents corresponding to Mercury (South America), Saturn (North America), and Mars (Asia). Golgotha / Jerusalem, as the Earth's Sun (heart) chakra, being of spiritual significance for the whole world, does not lie on either of the two great ley arteries, but is central like the Sun.⁹

According to Rudolf Steiner, the region of Oceania was where the Moon was located before it separated out from the Earth.¹⁰ As part of Oceania, Australia comes under the influence of the Moon—also in an evolutionary sense, since the Aborigines, comparing

their culture with that of the Lemurians described by Steiner,¹¹ are evidently descendants from the ancient Lemurians, a culture associated with the lunar influence as an echo of the Ancient Moon stage of evolution. Steiner described Lemuria as a continent very much influenced by the Moon that was located in the region between Australia and Africa, in the general region where now the Indian Ocean is located. The continent of Lemuria came to a cataclysmic end tens of thousands of years ago.¹² The Aborigines are thought to have inhabited Australia for tens of thousands of years—supported by the archeological findings of human remains from Lake Mungo, Australia, dated to about 45,000 years ago—making the Aborigines the oldest continuous population outside of Africa.

The table offers a summary of our findings identifying the seven planetary chakras of the Earth, where the place of Christ's resurrection—Golgotha, Jerusalem—is the heart or Sun chakra of the Earth. In astrogeographia the latitude of Golgotha corresponds to the alignment of the stars on the Celestial Equator, or 0° declination. The three upper chakras are identified with locations in the northern hemisphere: Mount Shasta, California, with the crown chakra (Saturn); the Externsteine in Europe with the third eye chakra (Jupiter); and Mount Kailash, Tibet, with the larynx chakra (Mars). On the other hand, the three lower chakras are identified with locations in the southern hemisphere: Lake Titicaca on the border of Peru and Bolivia with the solar plexus chakra (Mercury);

Mount Agung on the island of Bali with the sacral chakra (Venus); and Uluru, Australia, with the root chakra (the Moon).¹³ Throughout Australia, the Rainbow Serpent is a personification of fertility and rain. In 1926 a British anthropologist Alfred Radcliffe-Brown coined the term “Rainbow Serpent” to describe the recurring myth of a snake of some enormous size living within the deepest waterholes, and described in the Aboriginal stories as descended from the larger being visible as the dark streak in the Milky Way¹⁴. Robert Coon adopted the term *Rainbow Serpent* to describe the great ley artery that runs through Uluru on its circuit around the globe. For the other ley artery he used the term *Plumed Serpent*, the name of the great deity of various Mesoamerican religions—the Feathered Serpent of the Olmecs, Quetzalcoatl of the Aztecs, and Kukulcan of the Maya.

Bearing in mind the deep truth of the words “as above, so below,” relating to the principle of correspondences between the macrocosm (“great world”) and the microcosm (“the little world” of the human being), it is interesting, in relation to the idea of two serpents encircling the globe, that Rudolf Steiner draws attention to two “snakes” within the human being:

There is a symbol that one must enliven within oneself. This is the Staff of Mercury (see Figure), the luminous staff with a black snake and a bright luminous shining snake. The snake is a symbol for the astral body. Every night the astral body sheds its skin; it throws off the used-up skin. The black snake is a symbol for this. Overnight it gets a new, shimmering skin, and this newly enlivened, beautiful, shining skin of the astral body is symbolized by the shining snake . . . this symbol, the Staff of Mercury, who is the “messenger of the gods.”¹⁵

Applying the principle of correspondences, we believe that Robert Coon's insight into two great ley arteries encircling the Earth is a true one, which is mirrored in the human being in the Staff of Mercury described by Rudolf Steiner, and that this is of significance for the interconnections between the seven planetary chakras located on the seven continents of the Earth.

Coming back to the prophecy of the Aboriginal Elders regarding the day of the solstice—for them the summer solstice—on December 21, 2020, it could be interpreted that there will be an upsurge of Divine Feminine energy from the center of the Earth, Shambhala, the realm of the Earth Mother, on December 21. And that for those people sensitive enough to attune to this subtle event aligning the heart of Mother Earth with the heavenly realm of the Pleiades, representing the Divine Feminine, there may be those who will bear witness on that day of the solstice and the great conjunction of Jupiter and Saturn, the perception of the “raising up” of the Rainbow Serpent that runs through Uluru. In this sense, this Great Conjunction 2020-12-21 on the day of the solstice could see an opening up of the earth to spiritual realms, which would be an opportunity, for all those who have pledged to serve the Spirit, for the start inwardly of a great transformation and influx of new impulses.

Courage is the virtue of Capricorn. It is against the background of the stars of Capricorn, where the great conjunction of Jupiter and Saturn becomes visible shortly after sunset on December 21.

Clearly, we will need to have great courage in order to face the times ahead. And, also, we are called upon to participate in Christ's work of the redemption of evil, at this time of the onslaught of evil. As indicated by Rudolf Steiner in connection with the practice of the Capricorn virtue of courage: "Courage becomes power of redemption."

COMMENT FROM ROBERT:When Lucky and I and 14 other people went to Uluru in 2009, we flew to Alice Springs on December 10 and we flew back to Melbourne on December 15. We had one overnight stay in Alice Springs combined with shopping there (almost a whole day), where there are many Aboriginal art stores—we also visited a small Steiner School there in Alice Springs.

In the time at Uluru, as well as circumambulating the sacred Uluru rock [see

we also visited Kata Tjuta and hiked there—not too far, because of the heat.

In connection with the Uluru resort center, it is a must to visit Wintjiri Arts Museum to experience the Aboriginal art—and there are two other Aboriginal art galleries there as well: Mulgara Gallery and Mingkiri Arts. It is a treat also to see there the Putitja Aboriginal Dancers (every day, except Wednesday and Thursday). Alas, we shall not be able to meet again at Uluru with Aboriginal Elder, singer, and community leader Bob Randall and his American wife Barbara, whom we met there in 2009, since Bob Randall passed on on May 12, 2015. In 2009, Bob and Barbara spent a whole evening (including dinner) with us. We told them about the upcoming event in January 2010 of the founding of the Sophia Community in Australia, and Bob Randall gave us his blessing as an Aboriginal Elder for the Sophia Community. The highlight of our visit there in 2009 was doing eurythmy at different locations around the sacred site of Uluru.

It is said that Uluru is the Divine Mother Portal of creation for the planet where all new expressions are dreamt of and conceived. In alignment with the beliefs of the Aboriginal people of Australia, Uluru is the place of Dreamtime where all creations begin. From the ancient legends of the Dreamtime, there is a story about a great ritual that was interrupted which has yet to be completed at Uluru. This ritual was meant to complete the great plan of the Earth Spirit. In the words of Indigenous Gadigal Saltwater man, Timothy Mark Fish:

“There's some big lore coming, big energy from ceremony all 'round the land and planet, old ways, tricky ways, big song needs singing, country needs to shake from a dancing that makes the air thick with the dust of the land and the voices of the people. Been spoken about for a long time this one through many generations Dreamings, many mobs Dreamings, time now for big change”.

A Great Solstice Ceremony on this December 21st is intended to increase the flow of life and consciousness from Inner Earth to Earth and from the Earth to the Sun and vice versa benefiting all beings and in support of Earth's rebalancing with all of its life forms. Julia Williams, in consultation with Lore Keepers, says, “The purpose of this Ceremony is for the Rainbow Serpent to become the Rainbow Bridge, to rise up to connect with the light of the sun and then penetrate deep into the heart of Mother Earth.” Whilst this Great Ceremony will be performed by the original indigenous people of this land, they are calling for the focused, prayerful intent of all peoples around the world. Kaluwatawarra (Trish Levitt) is a Gundungurra elder who invites us to be outside on the Earth at this time. “Facing Uluru from wherever you are, draw a circle on the Earth. Moving in an anticlockwise direction, which calls forth the ancestors of the past and invites them into ceremony with us, tap Mother Earth with both your hands until you feel connection with Her. Send your heart filled prayers and blessings.”
