THE SOPHIA GRAIL CIRCLE SOCIAL AND ECCLESIASTIC SACRAMENTALISM

This year the three primary themes upon which we will be focusing are:

- The Spiritual Background to the events of the External World, and the Cultivation of the Spiritual Faculty of Discernment,
- Sacramental Consultation in relation to social and ecclesiastic sacramentalism,
- and *Meditations on the New Testament* by Valentin Tomberg.

"Present-day events can only be understood if one turns the inner eye to the spiritual powers which are now moving among us. . . It will be the main concern of these spirits of darkness to bring confusion into the rightful elements which are now spreading on earth, and need to spread in such a way that the spirits of light can continue to be active in them." [Rudolf Steiner, *The Fall of the Spirits of Darkness*.]

Rudolf Steiner offered guidance to navigate these disparate times. The path of moral tact or discernment is the foundation for the virtue of justice in the relational world. The task is not to react out of sympathies and antipathies, but rather to observe the cultural patterns, and lead out of one's hard-gained sense of knowing and feeling for right action through discernment.

Discernment, as a spiritual faculty, can only be developed by spiritual methods, by questioning, examining, and analyzing one's own ideas, opinions, and conduct. Our critical, fault-finding tendencies must no longer be applied to the opinions and conduct of others but must be applied—with no holds barred—to our own self. We must be prepared to question every one of our own opinions, thoughts, and behaviors and test them against spiritual principles. Only in this way can the discernment that dissolves confusion be developed.

All those attending the Grail Training are requested to read *Meditation on the New Testament* in *Christ and Sophia,* by Valentin Tomberg (formerly published as *New Testament Studies*) and Rudolf Steiner's *The Fall of the Spirits of Darkness,* in preparation for our time together.

The gathering will begin with dinner at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday evening, May 20, followed by the Beatitudes Grail Circle. The program will end on Monday morning, May 24, with breakfast, after Sunday evening's Mass of the Lamb and His Bride and the blessing of John Plummer toward ordination in 2022.
