



From Eclipse To

Apocalypse

A Meditation Retreat

Arrival on Thursday afternoon, October 12 Departure on Monday morning, October 16

On August 21, 2017, millions of people gathered to witness what came to be called the *Great American Solar Eclipse*, the first eclipse whose path of totality travelled from coast to coast of the continental United States since 1918 (https://www.greatamericaneclipse.com/). Significantly, it was the first solar eclipse to be *exclusively* visible in this part of the world since 1257!

Despite the unique nature of this celestial event, it does not stand alone. During this retreat, we will consider the possibility that this event ushered the United States (and, in turn, the rest of the world) into a "time of eclipse"—an approximately seven year period that is now coming to a close.

While there was only one celestial marker showing that we were entering the time of eclipse, there are two celestial gateposts showing us the way out. The first is the annular solar eclipse that will take place on October 14, 2023, whose path likewise travels from coast to coast of the continental United States, after which it continues south and will be visible in South America.

It is this celestial event that we will be celebrating during our meditation retreat, turning our inner gaze to the spiritual significance of this eclipse and its companions in the past and the future. To be clear: we will *not* be in the path of totality of this annular eclipse. However, we will experience around 75% totality, and will venture out to witness it in the gorgeous setting of the Osage Forest of Peace (https://forestofpeace.org/).

Joel Matthew Park and Sam Guzman will be guiding us through different perspectives as we consider the events of the past (the August 21, 2017 eclipse and the Great Conjunction on December 21, 2020); events of the present (the annular solar eclipse of October 14, 2023 and the total solar eclipse of April 8, 2024); and the future (a total solar eclipse on August 12, 2045).

Gail Dupre and Richard Reho will be guiding us through movement (cosmic and sacred dance) as a way to connect more deeply to these events.

Presenters:

Joel Matthew Park is a husband, father, and Christian Hermeticist based in Copake, New York. From 2011 to 2019 he was a life-sharing coworker at Plowshare Farm (a Camphill affiliate), farming and candle making with people from a variety of countries, ages, and developmental backgrounds. During this time, he earned a certification in Social Therapy from the School of Spiritual Science through the Camphill Academy. He has been living and working in Camphill Village Copake since 2019. After a time devoted to elder care, he has become increasingly involved in teaching in the Camphill Academy, on topics such as Stargazing, the Karma of Vocation, Theosophy, the Human Soul, the Festival Year, and Philosophical Perspectives. Joel has been a student of Anthroposophy since 2008 and a Christian Hermeticist since 2010. In 2014, he met Phillip Malone; together, the two of them have been investigating the Tarot of Marseilles since 2016. Since then, Joel has led two retreats on "Tarot and the Art of Hermetic Conversation" (2017 and 2019). In 2015, he joined the Grail Knighthood, a group-spiritual practice offered through the Sophia Foundation. Through this, he met Robert Powell, whose work he had been studying since 2009. Since then, Joel has been working actively with him to continue the karma research Robert began in 1977 and exemplified in works such as *Hermetic Astrology*, volumes I and II, and *Elijah*, Come Again. After contributing to the Journal for Star Wisdom 2018 (published Nov. 2017), he became editor for the journal's continuation, the *Star Wisdom* series.
