



The higher goal of Choreocosmos is the union of divine and human existence.


It is a schooling in cultivating an ever greater awareness of and relationship with the spiritual world in truth and moral integrity and the striving to embody

The Seven Planetary Seals above, drawn by Rudolf Steiner in 1907, were carved into the columns in the first goetheanum in Dornach, Switzerland. They depict the transformation of energy and consciousness through each stage of Earthly evolution. Each seals contain the secret of the life force, which is manifested in it. The seals are related to each other by a process of metamorphosis. Each form is related to the one before and after it like a seed, sprout, stem, leaf, bud, blossom and flower. These forms are central to the planetary dances of Choreocomsos.

The program will focus upon life between death and rebirth—the journey of the soul through the planetary spheres—and the dances of the Sophia Grail Circle, Jacob's Ladder.
